Sub.: Order of the Competition Commission of India (CCI)

The Hon'ble CCI has issued an Order on the evening of 19th January, 2017 against several leading cement manufacturers including Ambuja Cements Ltd. (ACL) imposing a penalty at the rate of 0.3% of the average turnover of the last 3 financial years. In case of ACL, the amount of penalty works out to Rs.29.84 Crores.

The said Order is issued on the basis of complaint filed before CCI by the State of Haryana alleging that these cement companies including ACL had indulged into anti competitive practices by collusive pricing and limiting supply. In the context of the investigation, ACL has provided all the information and clarifications as and when required by the authorities.

The Management firmly believes that we have a strong merit in the case and has accordingly decided to file appeal before the Competition Appellate Tribunal (COMPAT) against this Order.

ACL has a long-standing commitment to fair competition as reflected in its Code of Business Conduct with a robust programme to ensure compliance with fair competition practices which includes comprehensive training policy in this regard.
